

4th Grade Reading Challenge

Magic Tree House is a series of children's books which take readers on different adventures through time - from the prehistoric land of dinosaurs to the imaginary world of Camelot. This is the reason why teacher Cvetanka Tomevska decided to introduce this amazing series as a reading challenge to her 4th grade class and, even though reading isn't everyone's "cup of tea", sometimes competitiveness takes over and turns students into "super readers".

Here is what those who managed to read the most had to say about the experience:

Neda Ostojic, who read 22 books, said that one of the main motives she had was that it pushed her to read more while gaining knowledge from the books.

Nemanja Milkikj, who read a total of 24 books in five weeks, agreed that leaning was a great motive, but added that what also motivated him was the prize they'd get and the teacher who continually encouraged him to read.

Something that helped keep *Hafsa Safiye Ter* motivated while she was reading the 10 books she chose from the series was definitely the teacher who encouraged her and, of course, the prize. But once she read the books, the biggest prize was the knowledge that she had received.

Sofija Jovanovska, managed to read 22 books in the five-week period and her main motivation was merely the content of the books, but something that strived her furthermore was the suspense of finding out what the prize was.



We were also interested in knowing how this challenge changed their reading habits.

One thing *Neda* could definitely say is that it helped improve her reading skills by so much.

Nemanja believes that he's started to have a higher liking to books which has made him spend more time reading than he usually would.

Hafsa said that a major change that she noticed is that her reading skills had improved and *Sofija* added that before she read these books, she only used to read books that were assigned in class, whereas now she reads books with over 300 pages with the desire to read them.

And if you are wondering what the prize was...well, they received certificates, some interesting books, their favourite sweets and, of course, the satisfaction of having completed the challenge.



All four students said that they enjoyed all the books they had read, but some were more interesting than others. For Neda, it was Dingoes at Dinner Time, Nemanja's favourite book was Sunset of the Sabertooth, while Hafsa's was Dolphins at Day Break. Sofija had a hard time choosing just one because she equally enjoyed Polar Bears past Bedtime and Day of the Dragon King.

In all the books they read the main characters are Jack and Annie, adventurous siblings from Frog Creek, Pennsylvania. Sofija and Hafsa liked them both, Neda liked Annie the best whereas Nemanja could identify more with Jack.




Spring Festival



Ema Josevska - VI


